More than 200 supporters of the movement for a Better APIA have lodged a requisition on the 25th July 1977 with the APIA Club asking the Board pursuant to the Companies Act to call an Extraordinary General Meeting and pass an ordinary resolution that the Board be removed and a Committee of (5) five Members as a Management be nominated from the floor.

These members have been moved to take this step through lack of confidence in the general performance of the present Board and have contributed their money to pay for the postage to advise members of the Meeting.

These Members were reluctant to take the serious step of calling an Extraordinary General Meeting but rather had wished to show their dissatisfaction at the Annual General Meeting.

The present step was precipitated by a number of factors, inter alia the expulsion of Mr. V. Capelletto, the summoning of a number of Members before the Board as a result of letters in which those Members had expressed their point of view to the newspapers, the stringent demand on Mr. J. LoBlanco in relation to certain aspect of the Election Campaign presently conducted by this ever-increasing movement for a Better APIA.

This movement essentially feels that the present Board, which has been entrenched for a number of years, has lost touch with the grass root feelings of Members and has forgotten the original objectives in the establishment of the Club.

The future of The Club now rests in the hands of those Members who are conscious of the potential and great mission that the Club could have in the Community.
