DECIMAL CURRENCY (actual size)



50 CENTS = 5/-

20 CENTS = 2/-

10 CENTS = 1/-

5 CENTS = 6d.

2 CENTS = 2.4d.

1 CENT = 1.2d.

There are 100 cents to one dollar and one dollar equals ten shillings (10/-). One shilling (1/-), being one-tenth of ten shillings, equals one-tenth of one dollar = 10 cents. One penny (1d.), being one-twelfth of one shilling (1/-), is therefore one twelfth of ten cents = 5/6th of one cent. The cent is the lowest unit and, when converting pence to cents, the equivalent is reckoned to the nearest cent, based on 5/6ths of a cent to one penny, e.g., 1d. = 1 cent, 5d. = 4 cents.

WRITING AMOUNTS IN DOLLARS AND CENTS

The dollar symbol is \$ a capital S with two vertical strokes through the centre. The dollar symbol goes before the dollar amount, example \$10

The cent symbol is simply a small c. The cent symbol goes after the cent amount. No full stop is required. It is omitted when the dollar symbol is used, examples 10c; one dollar ten cents is written \$1.10. Make sure there are TWO figures after the decimal point.

Writing a sum less than \$1, (e.g. when writing figures in columns) we put an 0 before the point. The Dollar Symbol must never be next to the point, examples \$0.35 = 35c (3/6d.) These sums are NEVER written as \$.35, etc.

Writing a sum less than 10c. When writing a cent amount less than ten cents in a dollar-cent expression, we put an 0 after the point and before the cent amount. Remember the first figure after the point shows TENS of cents, the second SINGLE cents. Example \$0.05 = 5c (6d.). Always make sure there are TWO figures following the decimal point.

Simplicity and Certainty. When writing money amounts, we need CERTAINTY, SIMPLICITY. Make sure the amount you write follows the above rules. Example: (1) \$50 or \$50.00; (2) \$0.05 or 5c or 5 cents; (3) \$2.05; (4) \$29.25.

Placing the Decimal Point. Handwritten — above the base line, centre of numeral. Machine-written — on the base line. For Banking — make it a dash, centre of numerals. Examples: Handwritten (1) \$3.75 Machine-written \$3.75. Banking (2) \$3-75 (Written as 'Three dollars 75').
